





Surgical scrubs



Before entering the operating area, disinfect hands and put on scrubs, cap, and mask.



In preparation for surgery, wipe-disinfect the work surface and have surgical gown and gloves at the ready.

Make sure that they do not come into direct contact with the skin or the work surface.



Perform surgical hand washing (before operation or after leaving the OR area between procedures) and surgical hand disinfection.



Open the sterile primary packaging without touching the gown.



After the exposure time has elapsed, use the sterile cloth included in the package for final drying.



The gowns are folded such that the inside faces out. Slip your fingers into the sleeves on either side and step away from the table.

The gown should unfold slowly downward.



Once it has completely unfolded, slide your arms in further.



Keep your hands inside the gown at all times.



Have someone else grasp the inside of the gown, pull it over your shoulders, and close the coat at your neck.



Have the other person tie the two additional bands on the inside of the gown.



Do not close the waistband until donning sterile gloves.



Remove the band from the green card and hold it secure.



Pass the green part to the assistant.



And then rotate carefully around.

After that, pull the tape out of the paper loop.



Tie the two bands into a bow at the side.



You are now ready for surgery.
